

**SECURITY WARNING:
E-MAIL 'PHISHING' SCAM**

Garden Island Federal Credit Union was recently the target of a phishing attack.

Phishing is the practice of sending an e-mail that appears to be from a financial institution with the goal of persuading online banking users to share sensitive information that can be used to commit fraud or identity theft.

This recent fraudulent e-mail is asking the receiver to answer a short survey and in return will receive \$80 credit to their account.

We did NOT send this message. Do NOT click on the link. Simply delete the message.

If you responded to the message by sharing personal financial information, please contact us immediately by phone (the number is listed below for your convenience). We will give you instructions for changing your password and taking other steps to protect your accounts.

Always remember that we will NEVER ask you to click on an e-mail link to share sensitive financial information. Please notify us whenever you receive a suspicious e-mail or have any other form of unsolicited contact from individuals seeking personal information about your accounts.
